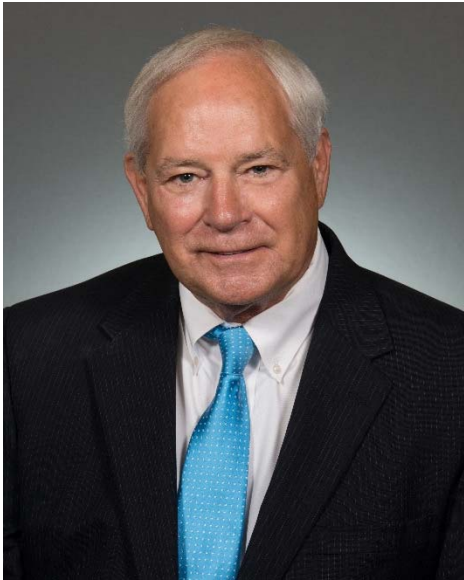


Peter Pearce Celebrates 50 Years of Service with Gulf Coast Truck & Equipment
