INVITATION FOR BIDS**

Sealed bids will be received by the County Commission of Mobile County (hereinafter called the County), in the Mobile Government Plaza, 205 Government Street, Eighth Floor South, Mobile, Alabama, until 10:00 a.m. Local Time, Wednesday, May 23, 2018, for the furnishing of all labor and materials and performing all work for constructing the following contract:

A pre-bid meeting will be held on Wednesday, May 16, 2018, at 10:30 a.m. Local Time in the Mobile County Engineering Department, Mobile Government Plaza, Sixth Floor South Tower, Mobile, Alabama for the purpose of briefing prospective bidders and DBE's about this project. All prospective bidders are urged to attend.

At the specified time, all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. The opening will be held in the Mobile Government Plaza, Mobile, Alabama.

Major items of work include the installation of Precision Approach Path Indicators (PAPI's) for Runway 12/30 at the Jeremiah Denton Airport in Dauphin Island, Alabama.

Approximate quantities include:

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| 1. Precision Approach Path Indicator (PAPI) Type L-881 (2 Box) Style B | - 2 EA |
| 2. No. 8 AWG, L-824, Type C Cable | - 4,150 LF |
| 3. No. 6 AWG, Solid Copper, Bare Counterpoise Wire | - 4,150 LF |
| 4. Removal of Existing PLASI Units | - 2 EA |

The project shall be completed within **120** Calendar Days of the Issuance of Notice to Proceed. Liquidated Damages for this project shall be **\$1,000.00** per Calendar Day.

Plans and specifications are on file and may be viewed in the Mobile County, Alabama, Engineering Department, or in the office of Volkert, Inc., Consulting Engineer, 1110 Montlimar Drive, Suite 1050, Mobile, Alabama.

Copies may be obtained from Volkert, Inc., Consulting Engineer, 1110 Montlimar Drive, Suite 1050, Mobile, Alabama 36609, (251) 342-1070 x 1187, upon payment of a deposit of \$50.00 to Volkert, Inc. The deposit will be refunded upon return of the documents in reusable condition within ten (10) calendar days after the bid opening. No plans and specifications will be issued to contractors later than forty-eight (48) hours prior to the time indicated above for receiving bids.

DBE participation is not required for this project; however, the utilization of minority businesses is encouraged.

Bids must be submitted upon the forms as issued to the prospective bidder by the Engineer. Guarantee will be required with each bid as follows: At least 5% of the amount of the bid, but in no event more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), shall be filed in the form of a certified check or bid bond payable to the Mobile County Commission.

Contract bond will be required as follows: 100% of the contract price.

Labor and Materials Bond will be required as follows: 100% of the contract price.

The awarding of the contract will require the Contractor to pay all workers on this project the prevailing scale of wages as noted in Division III, Section 160 and Division VI of the Contract Documents. All bidders must comply

with the President's Executive Order Number 11246, which prohibits discrimination in employment regarding race, creed, color, sex or national origin. All bidders must comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Davis Bacon Act, the Anti-Kickback Act, and the Contract Work Hours Act.

Certification of Non-segregated Facilities and Equal Opportunity Report Statement must be signed as included in the bid proposal. Failure to complete these forms may be grounds for rejecting bid.

No bids will be considered unless the bidder, whether resident or non-resident of Alabama, is properly qualified to submit a proposal for this construction in accordance with all applicable laws of the State of Alabama.

No contract will be awarded unless the contractor holds a current license from the State Licensing Board for General Contractors, Montgomery, Alabama. In addition, non-residents of the State, if a corporation, shall show evidence of having qualified with the Secretary of State to do business in Alabama.

No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of 120 days subsequent to the opening of bids without the consent of the Owner.

Prior to the award of a competitively bid contract to a contractor having one or more employees in the State of Alabama, Alabama law requires that the contractor provide the County proof of enrollment in e-Verify (see www.uscis.gov/everify).

The right is reserved to reject any or all bids and waive informalities in the bidding. If applicable to a contract resulting from this bid invitation, the successful bidder must comply with the Mobile County Contractor Felony Investigation Policy, available in the Engineering Department, or online at www.mobilecountypublicworks.net.
