Course Information

The Mobile Section, Alabama Associated General Contractors will offer a one-day course on **Temporary Traffic Control For Contractors on April 10, 2019**. This course will cover **Part 6 of the 2009 Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices**. One of the reasons for offering this course is to increase the awareness of the need for improved traffic safety in work zones. Work zones crashes have accounted for more than 1000 fatalities per year in the United States for the past few years. In Alabama, there have been over 30 work zone fatalities per year for the past few years. The course will begin at 8:00 a.m. and continue until 2:00 p.m. The course will be presented at the office of the Mobile Section, AlabamaAGC at 754 Downtowner Loop West in Mobile.

The registration fee of **\$125.00** per person will cover costs of course materials. Lunch will be the responsibility of the participants.
