

**SECTION A**  
**INVITATION FOR BIDS**

Sealed bids will be received by the County Commission of Mobile County (hereinafter called the County), in the Mobile Government Plaza, 205 Government Street, Eight Floor South, Mobile, Alabama, until 10:00 a.m. Local Time, Wednesday, May 27, 2020, for the furnishing of all labor and materials and performing all work for constructing the following contract:

**Mobile County Project No. CCP-151-15C**  
**Volkert Project No. 550003.19**  
**Replace Runway 12/30 MIRL & Construct New Electrical Vault**  
**Jeremiah A. Denton Airport**  
**Dauphin Island, Alabama**

At the specified time, all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. The opening will be held in Mobile Government Plaza, 205 Government Street, Mobile, Alabama.

A pre-bid meeting will be held on Wednesday, May 20, 2020, at 10:30 A.M. local time in Mobile County Engineering Office, Mobile Government Plaza, Sixth Floor South Tower, Mobile, Alabama for the purpose of briefing prospective bidders and DBE's about this project. All prospective bidders are urged to attend.

Major items of work include the replacement of Runway 12/30 medium intensity runway lighting (MIRL) system and construction of a new electrical vault at the Jeremiah A. Denton Airport.

Approximate quantities include:

The project shall be completed within **150** Calendar Days of the Issuance of Notice to Proceed. Liquidated Damages for this project shall be **\$500.00** per Calendar Day.

A Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goal of 10% has been established for this project. The Owner's award of this contract is conditioned upon Bidder or Offeror satisfying the good faith effort requirements of 49 CFR §26.53. As a condition of bid responsiveness, the Bidder or Offeror must submit the following information with their proposal on the forms provided herein:

- (1) The names and addresses of Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) firms that will participate in the contract;
- (2) A description of the work that each DBE firm will perform;
- (3) The dollar amount of the participation of each DBE firm listed under (1)
- (4) Written statement from Bidder or Offeror that attests their commitment to use the DBE firm(s) listed under item (1) to meet the Owner's project goal;
- (5) If Bidder or Offeror cannot meet the advertised project DBE goal; evidence of good faith efforts undertaken by the Bidder or Offeror as described in appendix A to 49 CFR Part 26.

Plans and specifications may be inspected at the Mobile County Engineering Office, Mobile Government Plaza, Sixth Floor South Tower, Mobile, Alabama.

will not require a deposit. Hard copies will require a deposit of \$50.00. The deposit will be refunded upon return of the documents in reusable condition within ten (10) days after the bid opening. No plans and specifications will be issued to contractors later than forty-eight (48) hours prior to the time indicated above for receiving bids.

Bids must be submitted upon the forms included within the contract documents and specifications issued to the prospective bidder by the Engineer. The contract documents and specifications must be printed, if obtained electronically, and must be submitted in their entirety. Guarantee will be required with each bid as follows: At least 5% of the amount of the bid, but in no event more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), shall be filed in the form of a certified check or bid bond payable to the Mobile County Commission.

Contract bond will be required as follows: 100% of the contract price.

Labor and Materials Bond will be required as follows: 100% of the contract price.

No bids will be considered unless the bidder, whether resident or non-resident of Alabama, is properly qualified with the State of Alabama. In addition, non-residents of the State, if a corporation, shall show evidence of having qualified with the Secretary of State to do business in Alabama.

No contract will be awarded unless the contractor holds a current and appropriate license from the State Licensing Board for General Contractors, Montgomery, Alabama. This project will require the Prime Contractor to possess a valid Alabama General Contractor's License with Heavy Railroad (HRR) and/or a Heavy Railroad Specialty (HRR-S) prior to awarding the contract.

No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of 120 days subsequent to the opening of bids without the consent of the Owner.

The right is reserved to reject any or all bids and waive informalities in the bidding.
